Dear Ms. Wilcox:


We have reviewed the data you submitted for the disposal of the wastewater from Renegade Parts Washer into the City's sanitary sewer. Based on the analytical results provided, the pollutants concentrations meet the local discharge limits; therefore, the City is approving the proposed potential discharge.

However, each individual industry is responsible for notifying the city for any process change which may change their wastewater characteristics. An evaluation would be made to determine if the user is subject to an Industrial Discharge Permit or would be regulated under the administrative guidelines given in the City of Bakersfield, Municipal Code, Chapter 14.12 Sewer. All dischargers are subject to random sampling and inspection according to our procedures.
