Subject: Potential Industrial Wastewater Discharge

Dear Ms. Wilcox:

Based on the data you submitted for review, there should be no problem with your request to dispose of the Renegade wastewater into sanitary discharge. However, each individual industry will need to complete the following steps before disposal can be allowed.

Below is the process for permitting potential industries for Clarksville Gas & Water.

Industries will be provided a pretreatment application to be completed and submitted. If it is determined by review of the application that the facility needs to be permitted, a General Discharge Permit will be issued, and the industry will have to meet the discharge parameters set forth in the permit. Clarksville Gas & Water has the authority to conduct routine inspections of permitted and potentially permitted industries.

If the completed application provides evidence that the industry does not need to be permitted, the facility must still comply with the requirements of Clarksville's Wastewater Discharge Regulations. Clarksville reserves the right to have the industry sample and submit results to ensure that the

Wastewater Discharge Regulations, EPA and local limits are being met. If these limits are exceeded, Clarksville will revisit the situation for possible permitting.
