Re: Potential Wastewater Discharge to City of Logan

Dear Ms. Wilcox:

We have reviewed the data you submitted for the disposal of wastewater from Renegade Parts washer into the City's sewer system. Based on the analytical results provided, the pollutants concentrations meet the local discharge limits; therefore, the City of Logan is approving the proposed potential discharge on a case by case basis. Each industry must notify the City of Logan prior to discharge that they intend to discharge so they can be placed on a schedule for future random sampling and inspections for compliance and to see if a discharge permit will be required.

Therefore each individual industry is responsible for notifying the City for any process change which may change their wastewater characteristics. An evaluation would be made to determine if the user is subject to an Industrial discharge Permit or would be regulated under the administrative guidelines given in the City of Logan, Municipal Code. All discharges are subject to random sampling and inspection according to our procedures.
